Within the framework of the 11th Biennale of Young Greek Architects, the School of Architecture, Faculty of Engineering of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki has planned a series of parallel events for 2024 at the premises of the School. All parallel events are coordinated by the Head of the School, professor Anastasios Tellios and the Vice Head, professor Dimitris Frangos. They are organized by a committee formed by members of the School, who represent its five departments [associate professor Apostolos Kalfopoulos - Department A, associate professor Vanessa Tsakalidou - Department B, assistant professor Loukas Triantis - Department C, assistant professor Sofoklis Kotsopoulos - Department D, associate professor Themis Hatzigiannopoulos - Department E].

The third parallel event opens on Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup> 2024, at 20.00 pm at the Exhibition Hall of the Faculty of Engineering, AUTh and will last until June 14, 2024. It is the **Exhibition of International Workshops**, entitled **'BREAKS'**. The exhibition is conceived, organized and curated by professor Styliani Lefaki and associate professor Vanessa Tsakalidou.

The protagonists of this exhibition are all those who participated in the International Workshops and contributed to their realization and mainly the students and professors from all international architectural schools, who traveled, collaborated and created, exchanging their knowledge and changing themselves; as people and as architects.

The exhibition, which takes place in the Exhibition Area of the Faculty of Engineering in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, presents informative and visual material related to the organization and results of the International Workshops, which took place over the last 2 years, thanks to the collaboration of the School of Architecture AUTh with universities abroad. These workshops, in which many students of our School participated, functioned complementary, enriching the educational process of the participants, in an international context of exchange of architectural knowledge and experiences, as well as cultivation of international friendship and cooperation.

The elongated Exhibition Area is temporarily transformed for the needs of the Exhibition. An undulating boundary formed by expanded polystyrene fragments runs through it, creating successive cavities which host the exhibits of the International Workshops, highlighting not only their 'results' but also taking a look behind the scenes of each collaboration and experience they offered.

The form and materiality of this boundary are inspired by the universal symbol of thermal insulation; a recurring theme in architecture and environmental technology. Thus, a reference is made to insulating layers and the use of thermal breaks, which create continuities and contribute to true continuous protection.

The title of the exhibition 'Breaks' is used as an allegory to describe the brief intervals in the academic process where students and teachers from different universities and countries connect and collaborate on a theme for an intensive period of time, exchanging knowledge and ideas while sharing memorable experiences in a different architectural, natural and human environment – in the spaces and countries they visit or in their own countries. Just like thermal breaks, these intensive workshops are seen as potential opportunities to create continuities, improve performance and transmit knowledge.
